Humility and Abraham Lincoln





Abraham Lincoln was the 16th President of the USA. He abolished slavery, led the country through a bitter Civil War, and helped to preserve the union and modernise the economy.

He was born into a poor family and his mother died when he was very young. With little formal education he had fewer prospects. This background contributed to his lifelong humility.

Lincoln taught and educated himself; training to be a lawyer before becoming involved in politics. He was passionate in his endeavours to abolish slavery and managed to do so without the country splitting in two. He had much to be proud of, but instead remained a humble man.

To be humble is about being modest of our own achievements. It is about accepting the applause and the congratulations, but not boasting or over-playing it. It is about giving other people credit and thanks, and acknowledging their role too.

It is a difficult life-lesson but one that is valuable to learn both in school and in life.
