Elizabeth Blackwell was born in the UK and moved to New York when she was 11.

Despite many setbacks, she became the first qualified female doctor in America and the first woman to be registered as a doctor in Britain.

Her driving force was her kindness to her patients, in particular to poverty-stricken women and children.

Her concern and care for them, led her to set up teaching colleges for other women, who also wanted to be medically trained to help.
