
STUDENTS AND STAFF CELEBRATE THE CORONATION






THE BIG BUNTING COMPETITION WINNERS!











FARADAY CHALLENGE

On Friday 5th May 2023, six year 8 pupils went to Portsmouth University for the day to compete in this year's Faraday STEM challenge. Upon arrival, students were faced with a 'flight' brief, and they had to design and make a prototype which they would present in front of other local schools and judges. The prototype they designed enabled delivery drones to travel across seas with the help of charging points positioned in the ocean. The student used LED's and sensor pads to show how their model would work allowing the drone to charge between deliveries. A huge well done to the students who participated in this day!
