

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
At Castle View Academy we expect you to look smart and wear the correct uniform from day one.





Uniform incudes wearing the correct PE kit which must be brought into school on the days you have




Students will also take part in dance lessons.


School Building

School Day

What is roll call?

Roll call is an opportunity for your tutor to check that you are prepared for the day's learning.

Lessons

Each day you will have different lessons. For each lesson you will move classrooms. Our timetable is made up of 2 weeks (Week A and Week B). You will be given a timetable which will tell you what lesson you have and where it is.



You will need to bring the correct equipment with you in a sturdy school bag. Below is the equipment you will need to bring to school **everyday.**




During tutor time, your tutor will check you have the correct equipment by using the equipment mat:



Behaviour

We believe in rewards rather than sanctions, but sometimes poor behaviour will result in consequences.

All students will have a "CV card" that gets marked when a student does something that does not meet our expectations e.g., not wearing the correct uniform. If you get too many marks on your card, unfortunately, there will be a sanction.



If you reach the end the week without any marks on your CV card, you will receive "Epraise" points. Epraise is a way of recording points for good behaviour and efforts. Points can be traded for treats, vouchers and lots more.



Homework

Each week you will be expected to complete homework in your homework booklet for different subjects. We expect homework to be completed to the highest standard you can achieve.

If you are struggling to complete your homework, you can talk to your subject teacher or go to homework club (run by the SEN team) for extra support.



Canteen

We operate a cashless canteen system which means we don't accept cash for food purchases. Your account can be topped up at the machine in school or at home on the internet. You will be given a pin code on your first day which is what you will use to buy your food. Alternatively you can bring your own food to eat at break and lunchtime.
